## **Itinerary**

Sunday, August 18 - On your arrival in Edinburgh, Scotland, a representative of Scotland Tours & GSGA will meet you and introduce you to your drivers and Tour Manager. Two coaches will be arranged so that departure times can be staggered from the hotels to the courses. You will then travel to Inverness. En route, a tour and tasting will be arranged at the excellent Tullibardine Distillery, followed by a light lunch. Tonight you will enjoy a Welcome Dinner in your hotel, Kingsmill Hotel & Spa. Overnight in Inverness — Full driver services included today.

**Monday, August 19** - Today, half the group will enjoy golf at the famous **Royal Dornoch Golf Club**. The other half will play the championship course at the equally historic **Nairn Golf Club**. Spliting the group into two manageable sizes at these courses will aid tee time accessibility and also remove lengthy delays on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee. The groups will be reversed tomorrow. *Non-golfers will travel to Dornoch initially and then on to Dunrobin Castle for a tour of the castle and a falconry exhibition. Return to Dornoch later and have time to explore this quaint highland village with its famous Cathedral. This evening golfers are free to explore the city of Inverness. Overnight in Inverness – Full driver services included today.* 

**Tuesday, August 20 -** Today half the group will enjoy golf at **Nairn Golf Club**. The other half will play the championship course at **Royal Dornoch Golf Club** in a reversal of yesterday's plans. *Non-golfers will have a boat trip on Loch Ness and have a tour of Urquhart Castle with some free time in Inverness.* This evening you are again free to explore the city of Inverness. **Overnight in Inverness – Full driver services included today.** 

**Wednesday, August 21** - This morning will be a free morning. Those who wish a short sail on Loch Ness and brief tour of Urquhart Castle (Supplement £25) can do so before travelling to **Castle Stuart** - now known as **Cabot Highlands** - for a light lunch. Everyone plays at Castle Stuart Golf Links this afternoon. *Non-golfers will have a tour of Cawdor Castle and Gardens this afternoon*. **Dinner** will follow golf in the iconic art deco style clubhouse overlooking the Moray Firth. After golf, return to your hotel for your final night in Inverness. **Overnight in Inverness** – **Full driver services included today**.

Thursday, August 22 - Today you will check out of your hotel in Inverness and travel south to Edinburgh. A leisurely drive south, stopping for lunch to break the journey around Perth. Continue to the city of Edinburgh where guests can enjoy some of the many attractions available due to the famous Edinburgh Festival being in full swing at this time. An early dinner will be included so guests can attend an evening performance of their choice. Details of how to book tickets to performances (comedy, music, art, theatre, etc.) will be supplied nearer the date. Check into hotel, Kimpton Charlotte Square. Overnight in Edinburgh — Full driver services included today.

Friday, August 23 — This morning, travel to Gullane for a round on their two championship courses. We will be using both Gullane 1 and Gullane 2 today to fit in with tee time availability. Both are excellent links courses sitting adjacent to each other. A composite course was created from these two courses when it hosted Scottish Opens in recent years for both men and women. An early dinner in the clubhouse will follow before returning to Edinburgh. Non-golfers will have a free day in Edinburgh. A professional tour guide will be with the group to give a walking tour of the Royal Mile. Dinner is included for Non-golfers in a city centre restaurant and the group will meet up with the golfers in the early evening. This evening the entire group will have tickets supplied to attend the famous Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo, a spectacular event that is not to be missed. Overnight in Edinburgh — Full driver services included today.

Saturday, August 24 — The final game of the tour will be played at the excellent **Dumbarnie Links**. This new addition to the amazing choice of classic links courses in Fife should be on every goflers bucket list. This evening you will enjoy a final night group dinner in the city. **Overnight in Edinburgh** — **Full driver services included today**.

**Sunday, August 25 -** Return to the Ediburgh airport taking with you fantastic memories of a wonderful Scottish golfing vacation. **Airport transfer included today.**
